The whole systems energy modelling consortium ([wholeSEM](http://www.wholesem.ac.uk)) is a ground breaking, multi-institution initiative to develop, integrate and apply state-of-the-art energy models. Our aim is to employ extensive integration mechanisms to link and apply interdisciplinary models to key energy policy problems. Funded by EPSRC, the consortium is led by University College London and consists of Imperial College London, the University of Cambridge and the University of Surrey.

On Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th July 2015, wholeSEM will be holding its 2nd Annual Conference in Cambridge titled 'Hybrid Energy Modelling – Linkages and Interdisciplinarity'. The conference will attract experts from the UK energy modelling community and from leading international teams along with technically minded industry and government decision makers.
